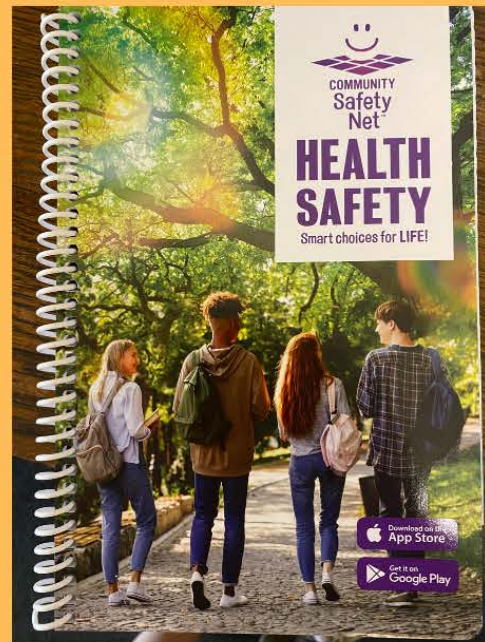
Our Story Time families are joining us once again! Here are a few of the kids with the ladybug craft Jolene had them work on
